Working at Jaguar has been incredibly rewarding, helping me grow and meet amazing people along the way.












Georgia Crosthwaite

Senior Health & Safety Administrator


I joined Jaguar in 2019 and have recently celebrated my six-year anniversary with the business. Over the years, my role has developed into a more technical position rather than being solely office-based.
